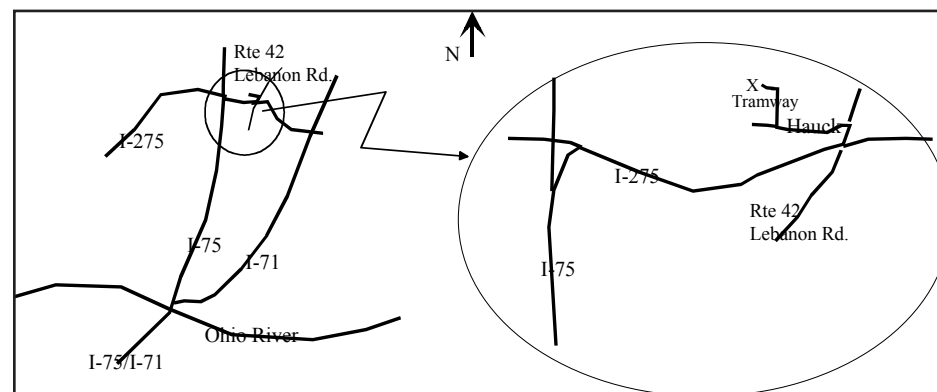

### Directions To The Trial

**From the North or East:** Take I-71 or I-75 to northern loop of I-275. From I-75, proceed east on I-275 to exit 46; from I-71, proceed west to exit 46 on I-275. From exit 46 off I-275, go north on Rte. 42 (Lebanon Road) for 1 block (just past Monroe Auto Care & before White Castle), turn left on Hauck Road. Proceed on Hauck for about 1 mile, turn right on Tramway. Proceed to end of Tramway, past Fossil Park. Queen City Dog Training Club is on the right.

**From the South:** North on I-75 thru city of Cincinnati, to northern loop of I-275. East on I-275 to second exit (Exit 46, Rte. 42, Lebanon Rd.). Left on Rte. 42 for 1 block, turn left on Hauck Rd ( just past Monroe Auto Care & before White Castle). Proceed on Hauck for about 1 mile, turn right on Tramway. Proceed to end of Tramway, past Fossil Park. Queen City Dog Training Club is on the right.

**From the West:** I-74 to I-275 east, proceed to exit 46 on I-275, proceed as above.



AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

INSTRUCTIONS

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (long-haired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard). A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

All classes with jumps, shall be arranged in jump height order beginning at 4 inches and ascend up.

Notice to UDX Class Entrants – those wishing to enter the UDX class should designate that obedience trial class on their entry. If either the Open B class or the Utility B class has filled at the time an entry for the UDX class is received, it will be returned to the entrant. Those wishing to enter both the Open B class and the Utility B class should mark their entries for each class. If one, but not the other class has been filled at the time your entry is received, your entry will be accepted for the class that has not been filled. A refund of fees will be provided for the class that has been filled in the amount of the entry for the same dog in a second class.

Vaccinations – Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians’ recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, and any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Neither the Trial Committees nor the Trial-giving Club will be responsible for the loss or damage on the trial grounds, whether as a result of an accident or any other cause. It is clearly understood that every dog entered in the trial is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the trial premises.
